Learning Objectives	

By the end of this training session, participants will be able to:

- 1. Recognise economic challenges faced by migrants when integrating into the labour market:
- 2. Examine methods to integrate young people into communities through employment opportunities.

20-minutes	Economic Integration and Empowerment.	Module Four

	Split the participants into two groups.	Slide 2	
	Each group will be provided with one sheet of paper. One sheet will state "integration" and one sheet with "empowerment".	2 sheet of paper	
	Groups will be asked to brainstorm & write down anything that comes to mind when working with their target group (5-minutes).		
	After 5-minutes, the groups should exchange sheets and they should add anything else that comes to mind.		
	One representative from each group should present the discussions to the findings.

	The facilitator will present the overview of module four to the group.	Slides 3 – 4	

15-minutes	Migrants face unique economic challenges when trying to integrate into a new country	Module Four PowerPoint Slide 5 – 14
	Present the content on slides 5 – 13. Encourage knowledge sharing, ideas and experience from the participants.	
	Harvest this information onto the whiteboard.	
20-minutes	Employment Support	Module Four PowerPoint
	Invite the participants to discuss common challenges that they hear from young people that they work with when trying to access the labour market.	Slides 15 - 19
	Explore the European Websites on slide 17 that can be used by job seekers when looking for employment.	
	Using SMART goals on slide 18, invite the participants to set their own action plan using the SMART acronym.

	Invite the participants to create an account on the website and create their own basic CV on the website.
